What is the Au Pair Program?

The Au Pair program started in Europe after World War II as a cultural exchange, giving young people the chance to live abroad, learn a language, and experience life with a host family.

What began as an informal arrangement has grown into a global program that fosters mutual understanding, personal growth, and lifelong connections.



Who is an Au Pair?

An Au Pair is a young person, who lives with a host family in a foreign country to experience cultural exchange. Au Pairs provide childcare and light household assistance in exchange for room, meals, and pocket money.

Who Can Become an Au Pair?

- Be aged 18 to 29 years old.
- Be in good health.
- Hold a clean criminal record.
- Possess a strong command of English (B2 level or above).
- Have a genuine interest in cultural exchange and working with children.
- Have previous childcare experience (e.g., babysitting, tutoring, or similar roles).



About Our Company

Before joining the host family

After the Au Pairs arrive in Chengdu, they will have a 2-day orientation. We will provide them with a hotel room, meals, a VPN, a SIM card, and three important training sessions:



1. How to use Chinese apps
2. How to build a connection with a Chinese host family
3. How to teach kids English, along with useful resources for various English activities

Our family visits are an important part of how we support our Au Pairs and host families. By visiting in person, we can build trust, create stronger connections, and help solve any challenges quickly.

These visits allow us to identify and resolve any issues early, offer guidance, and ensure that both sides feel supported.

An Au Pair's duties

Au Pairs usually work 30–35 hours per week, with sufficient free time for personal activities, language learning, and exploring Chinese culture. Au Pairs have 1.5 days off per week and an additional 3 days off every 3 months.

Most Chinese host families hire a housekeeper to handle cooking and cleaning the apartment, so there's no need for Au Pairs to prepare meals or clean shared spaces.

An Au Pair's duties are typically based on the specific needs of the host family, but they often include:

CHILDCARE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Take children to school and extracurricular activities, and pick them up afterward.
- Be a positive role model for the children.
- Accompany children on trips or family activities.

TEACHING ENGLISH

- Teach children English and help improve their language skills through fun and interactive activities.
- Help children with their homework or school projects, particularly English-related subjects.

FAMILY INVOLVEMENT

- Participate in family outings or activities to enhance cultural exchange.
- Introduce your country's culture to the host family.

PERSONAL SPACE MAINTENANCE

- Keep your private room clean.
- Wash your clothes regularly and keep your laundry organized.

2. Interview with Masons Au Pair agency

Have an interview with our team to discuss your goals and program details. Afterward, we'll post your self-introduction video in our matching pool, and our manager will guide you through the entire process.

3. Match with a host family

We'll match you with a host family that fits your profile, interests, and preferences. After reviewing their details, you can decide whether to move forward or wait for another match.

4. Online meeting with the host family

Our manager will join the interview with the host family to help with translation if needed. It's a great chance for you to ask questions and get to know the family and their child better.



Program Enrollment Process

5. Approval of work schedule and duties

Finalize and approve the work schedule and responsibilities with your host family.

6. Contract approval

Review and sign the contract outlining your terms and conditions for the program.

7. Visa application and flight booking

We will send you all the necessary documents for your visa and assist you throughout the entire visa application process. Once you receive your visa, our agency will book your flight to China.

8. Arrival in Chengdu and 2-day orientation

Upon arriving in Chengdu, you'll take part in a 2-day orientation to help you settle in. We'll provide hotel accommodation, meals, a SIM card, and a VPN. You'll also learn how to use local apps, navigate the subway, build healthy relationships with your host family and kids, teach English effectively, and use our prepared teaching materials.

9. Welcome to your host family!

Finally, you'll be welcomed into your host family's home, ready to begin your cultural exchange experience!



What Do We Need from You?

To join our Au Pair program, we'll need a few important documents to get started. These help us ensure a smooth application process and match you with the best host family. Here's what we'll need:

1. Application Form

2. Self-Introduction Video – A short video introducing yourself, your hobbies, and why you want to join the program.

3. Proof of Education – A certificate or diploma confirming you've completed high school or equivalent.

4. Health Certificate – A recent medical checkup confirming you're in good health.

5. Police Clearance Certificate

6. Photos – Recent photos of yourself, preferably including a few with children.

7. A Valid Passport – A scanned copy of the first page to book your flight.



Self-Introduction Video

1. Say Hello!

Introduce yourself — name, age, and where you're from. Be natural and friendly!

2. About You

Share your personality, education, hobbies, and interests.

3. Your Family

Briefly introduce your family — siblings, family life, etc.

4. Childcare Experience

Talk about your experience with kids — babysitting, tutoring, or working in schools/camps.

5. Why Become an Au Pair?

Explain why you want to join the program and what excites you most.

6. Skills & Family Preferences

Mention what you can offer (childcare, language, culture) and describe the kind of host family you'd like.

7. Wrap Up

End with a warm smile and a friendly goodbye!



Au Pair Introduction Video Tips

1. Background

Film in a quiet, tidy space with good lighting — avoid backlight.

2. Be Genuine

Share real examples of your childcare experience to make it engaging.

3. Stay Natural

Don't read from a script — speak confidently and relaxed.

4. Smile & Be Friendly

Use light gestures and positive energy to appear approachable.

5. Length

Keep your video 3–5 minutes long.
